

## **Q1 Commentary**

The first quarter of 2025 was marked by significant volatility in global financial markets, largely influenced by trade policies and geopolitical developments. The declaration of plans to re-impose of broad tariffs by President Trump spooked markets. S&P 500 dropped ~4.6%, the worst quarterly performance since 2022. The Fed maintained a cautious stance, keeping rates higher for longer amid sticky inflation. Meanwhile, the ECB and BoJ signaled potential easing, reflecting weaker growth outlooks. In Europe, FTSE 100 and Stoxx 600 gained ~3–5% benefiting from defense spending and expectations of ECB stimulus and cheaper valuations + stronger fiscal support drove rotation into EU assets. In China, Hang Seng Index rose 7%, & Shanghai Composite +5%. In fixed income markets, strong demand for safe assets led to gains in longer-dated bonds. 10-year yield US Treasury fell from 4.25% to 3.9%, boosting total return of ~2.9% on aggregate indexes. Gold recorded new high due to inflation hedge and geopolitical stress. Oil declined to 58\$/barrel reflecting slowing global demand especially in China. In this context, the TRITON Balanced fund recorded a return of -1.88% at the end of the first quarter, overperforming its index by 0.98%.
